






Outcomes for Consumers

Case study of collaborative practice

- 23 year old Mary admitted to St Vincent's hospital following suicide attempt, now homeless
- Referral to Launch housing
- Linked with HOPE program
- Joint care plan leading to long-term housing secured and stabilised mental health
- 12 months later still housed, stable mental health, appropriate services in place

Outcomes for Consumer Programs

Case study of shared knowledge

- FaPMI Coordinator introduced program
- "Juggling it all" Program 12-24 year olds
- Held at Artful Dodgers Studio
- Program shared through alliance networks
- FaPMI Conducting capacity building workshop for Connexions practitioners
